**From South Spokane:**  
Drive North on Walnut. Turn right on 3rd. Turn right on Jefferson. Follow signs into parking lot under freeway.

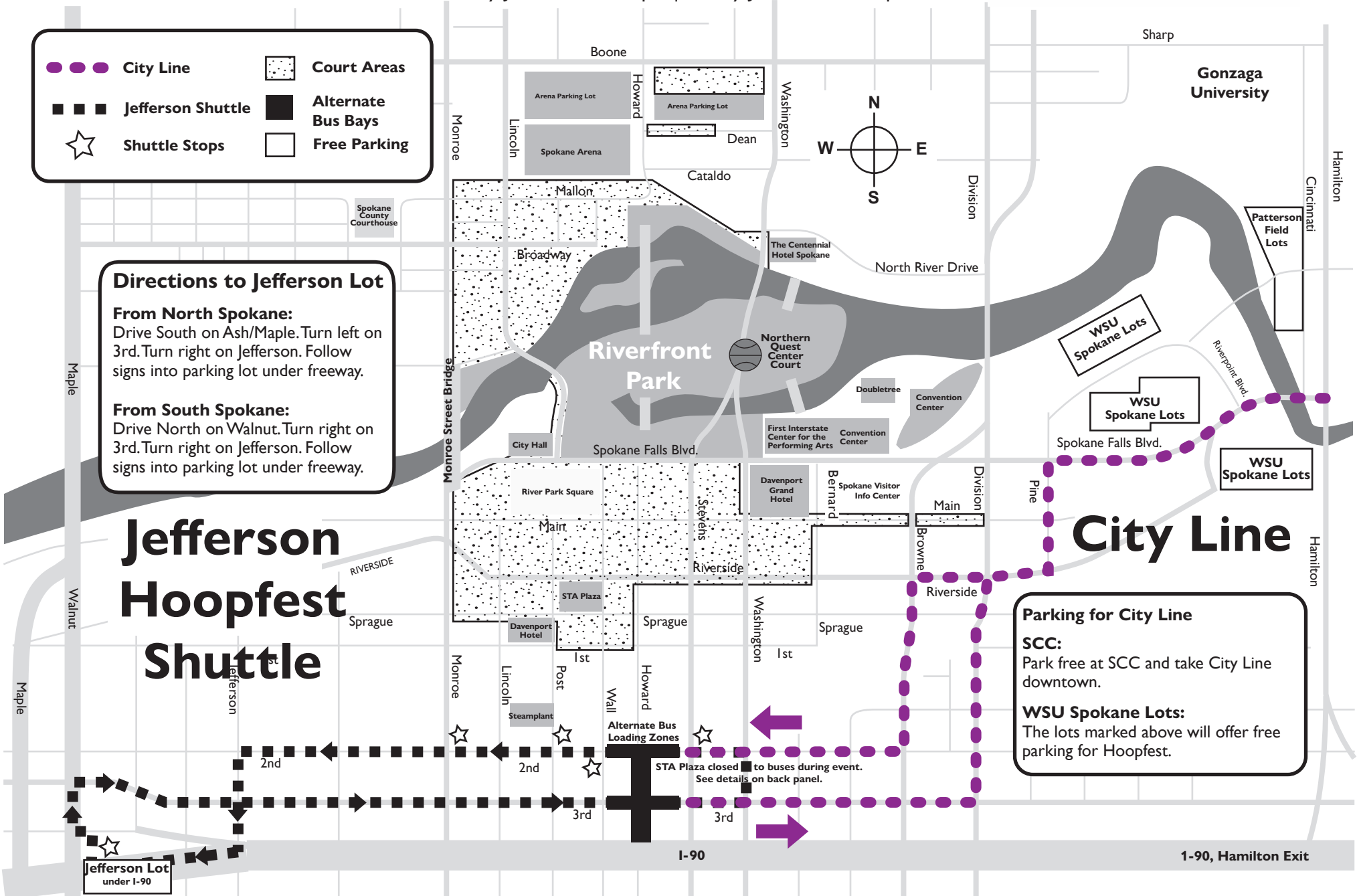

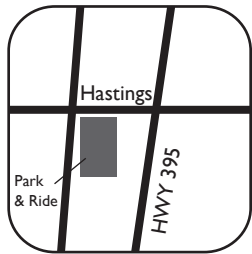
# How do I get downtown?

- Use regular bus service.

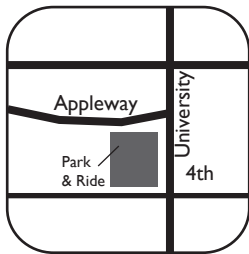

## Popular Park & Ride Lots

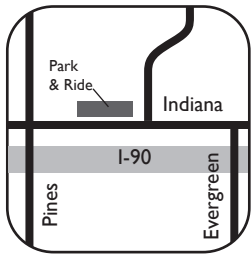
Routes go downtown unless otherwise noted (e.g. #34 Freya to SCC). These routes connect to another route that goes downtown.



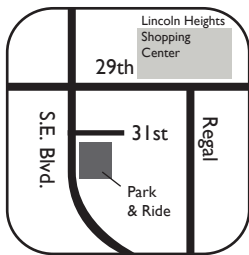

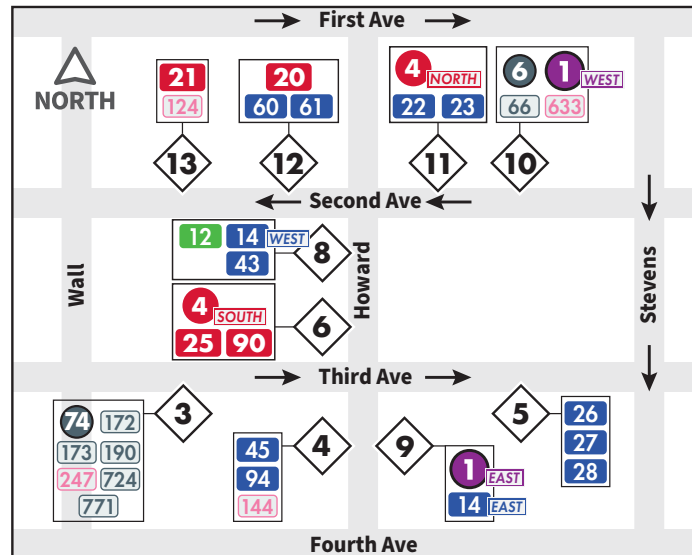

## How to Get Downtown

### 1. Regular Bus Service

Spokane Transit operates bus service on Saturday and Sunday during Hoopfest, but STA Plaza is closed to traffic during the games. STA will use alternate zones to drop off and board riders.

### 2. City Line

Park for free at SCC or WSU and take City Line to Hoopfest. City Line will drop off at Howard & 2nd. Boarding will be at Howard & 3rd.
