JOB SUMMARY

Principal person in charge of the identification, contact, recruitment and stewardship of sponsor, corporate and community partners. Responsible for sales, service, and fulfillment of sponsorships for all programs. This person oversees the creation and development of sponsor able assets and sales strategy for all organizational programs and initiatives.

JOB DUTIES/RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Sponsorships

- a. Identify, prospect and secure Major, Official, Supporting and Court sponsors for Hoopfest and Presenting and School Sponsors for the Hooptown Youth League.
- b. Develop and execute the court sponsor program to meet established objectives.
- c. Build lasting relationships with sponsors to grow value for both partner and SHA organization.
- d. Create sales strategy for all programs and initiatives beyond Hoopfest Week.
- e. Negotiate, execute, and manage contracts with sponsors and partners, including invoicing and payment tracking.
- f. Organize and execute sponsor deliverables, including specific event activations.
- g. Track and maintain all current sponsor information and related details, including names, addresses, contacts, logos, contracts, sponsorship amounts, and receipts.



- 2. Identify other funding and develop sources such as grants and foundations to further support our organization and programs.
- 3. Organize Hoopfest tournament services and oversee the Operating Committee chairperson in the following areas:
 - a. Festival, including contest activities and other events.
 - b. Tip-off party preparations and execution
 - c. Welcome and orient Hoopfest's invited guests, including sponsors.
- 4. Work closely with the appropriate teammate and area to create the best basketball experiences on earth.
 - a. This role works closely with the Site and Facilities Director, Marketing and Brand Director and the Executive Director.
- 5. Involvement in new avenues of pursuit, both inside Spokane and for out-of-town activities, as assigned by the Executive Director.
- 6. Be prepared to help with the organization and coordination of event specific logistics and labor. Be willing and available to help where needed for all programs and events.
- 7. Other responsibilities as assigned; with the expectation to help the team when needed regardless of stated job duties. Other assignments will not be such that it reduces the capacity to initiate and run projects as described above.
